All email and telephone entries must include/be followed up with a completed entry form and payment must be received within 3 working days, places are not guaranteed until payment received.

Awards: Trophies and medals will be awarded in relation to the number of entries. Awards will be given for the highest scores **across both sessions**. Whilst archers are more than welcome to shoot both sessions, only their morning session score will count for the purpose of awards.

Recurve Awards - Ladies, Gentlemen, Novice *(Archer in his/her first full year of membership)*,
Veteran (Archer over 50 years of age)

Seddy's Other Mug – Archer with the most blues *(All bow styles and ages)*

Compounds/Longbows/Barebow – *(Individual awards according to entries on the day)*

Team Awards - *(According to entries on the day)*

Juniors U18, U16, U14, U12 – *(According to entries on the day. Two competing archers are required per age classification for a medal to be awarded, archers of different age classifications will be grouped so that at least two archers compete in the older age classification).*

Will last year's trophy winners please return them (cleaned) on or before the day of the tournament.

Tournament Notes:

- The event will be shot to Archery GB rules of shooting and dress regulations will be enforced.
- Archers will shoot at 60cm faces except compounds who will shoot at 3 spot faces. There will be 2 archers per face, shooting in 2 details.
- Proof of GNAS membership may be requested at registration.
- Anyone wishing to take photographs or use a camcorder MUST report to the tournament organiser before the start of the tournament.
- The target list will be posted in the sports hall on the day
- Trophies and medals will be awarded in relation to the number of entries, results will be posted on the YAA website.
- Laminated foam bosses and back stop netting will be used. Chantry Bowmen cannot be held responsible for arrows passing through the targets or any loss/damage to equipment whilst at the tournament.
- NO SMOKING is allowed in the sports hall, indoor shoes with light coloured soles are only allowed.
- Refreshments are available at the main pavilion between 9.15am and 5pm (150M flat walk from the sports hall).
- Archers shooting in the afternoon session, are requested to leave their equipment outside of the sports hall, until the morning session have finished shooting.
- Two single disabled toilets are available within the sports hall, full facilities are in the main pavilion (150M flat walk from the sports hall).
- There is ample parking alongside the sports hall, with more spaces at the main pavilion. Vehicles are parked at the owner's risk; Chantry Bowmen cannot be held responsible for any loss or damage.
- The term 'Novice' applies to archers who have not yet completed their first year of affiliation.
- The term 'Veteran' applies to archers aged 50 or over.
- The following information may be collected and shared with tournament organisers, scoring systems and other competitors for example target lists and results may be published: First Name, Surname, Gender, Bow style, Date of Birth / Age category, Email, Address, Phone number, Club (and ID), County (and ID), Region (and ID), Round (unless defined by age), Disabled (Y/N), Disability info.
- Archers with disabilities or special needs should contact the tournament organiser to discuss their needs at the time of entry, every effort will be made to satisfy their requirements wherever possible.

You will be expected to abide by the following Covid 19 protocols

- If you or any member of your household has Covid 19 symptoms, then you must not attend the tournament.
- Contact the tournament organiser if within ten days of attending the tournament, you test positive or are instructed to self-isolate.
- The wearing of face coverings is not mandatory but recommend when not actively shooting.
- Archers are encouraged to maintain sensible social distancing, use gloves and/or pull only their own arrows wherever possible.
- Archers are encouraged to bring their own sanitiser, face coverings, and any other item to enable them to feel safe at the tournament.
